

MAUGANS AVENUE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

November 17, 2005

1. Tom Mooningham asks if mail delivery will be maintained.
Per Gary Rohrer, mailboxes will be on respective side.
2. Would like to have all residents notified when County holds meeting on sidewalk ordinance.
3. Address landscape details around pond for screening.
4. Utility relocation – how long will utilities be down?
5. Will utility work occur at night?
6. Construction duration will be 15 months.
7. Maugans Avenue access from Royal Road concerns.
8. Concerns about the sight distance at Petmar Circle toward Sheetz.
9. Will additional fire hydrants be placed on Maugans Avenue.
Per Dave Mason, City Water is planning some upgrade to the existing water lines but uncertain about any additional fire hydrants.
10. Center lane at Mack Truck is now passing lane, left turns at I-81 Southbound, U-turning at Shawley are current concerns with Maugans Avenue. Request for signs to SHA.
11. Request for Cloverleaf at I-81 Interchange.
Per Terry McGee, no major work is planned for the interchange because of I-81 widening in the future. SHA has done roundabout analysis at the interchange.
12. Resident Gary Ellis from 13625 Dixie Drive (301.733.1574) requests a 4-way stop at Orchard Hills and Dixie Drive.
Per Gary Rohrer, County will monitor traffic during construction; will also seek Sheriff's patrol assistance.
13. Sight distance due to vertical curve at Mack Truck.
Per Dave Mason, will lower high point by 1 foot.
14. Will increasing the road from two lanes to five lanes lead to more traffic?

15. This project will increase traffic; this road is cutting through a community. Does not like pond behind his house.
16. Water from Maugans Avenue on Royal Road, will this project address the water? Concern over growth in area and effect upon transportation network.
17. What is the difference in 4-way stops that were installed in Maugansville?
Per Terry McGee, explanation of warrant.
18. How will ramps be modified to accommodate queue of signal.
Per Gary Rohrer, the response is modeled.
19. Petmar Circle experiences flooding in basements; will a pond affect this?
Per Rob Slocum, will show details.
20. With the recent reclamation, does the County have plans to develop the area along Maugansville Road?
21. Will pond hold water for short term only?
