◆◆◆ FACTS FOR VOTERS ◆◆◆

You can vote if you:

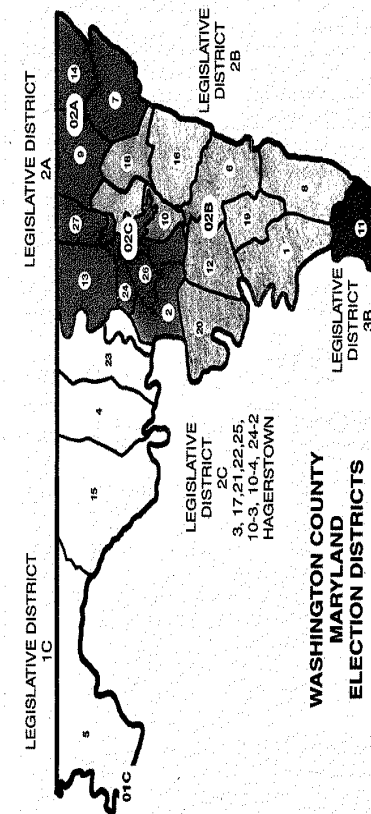
- ◆ are a citizen of the U.S.
- ◆ are a resident of the county and registered before the books close 21 days before the election
- ◆ will be 18 years old on or before the general election
- ◆ have not been convicted of buying or selling votes; have not been convicted more than once of a crime of violence; have not been convicted of an infamous crime (unless you have been pardoned or, for a first conviction, you have completed your sentence, or, for a second or later conviction, 3 years have passed since you completed a sentence)
- ◆ are not under guardianship for mental disability

How to Register:

- ◆ By mail or in person at the Board of Elections located at 35 W. Washington St., Rm. 101, Hagerstown, MD 21740, any weekday from 8:00am to 4:30pm, or call for an application to be mailed 240-313-2050.
- ◆ Pick up an application at any post office, school or State agency, or Motor Vehicle Administration – when you apply for a drivers license, picture ID, change your address, or change your name on your drivers license.
- ◆ First time voters in Maryland now have to provide their full drivers license number; if they do not have a drivers license, then the last four digits of their Social Security number, for verification of identity.
- ◆ An application may be downloaded from the State website at – <http://www.elections.state.md.us>, completed and mailed to the Election Office. (address shown above)

Once you register and vote, let your representatives know how you feel about the issues or legislation. Contact your representative by

letter or telephone.
