

**RESOLUTION SETTING HOMESTEAD CREDIT  
PERCENTAGE FOR TAXABLE YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2007**

Section 9-105, Tax-Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the governing body of a county on or before November 15, 2006 shall set, by law, a homestead credit percentage for the taxable year beginning July 1, 2007 and any subsequent taxable year.

The homestead credit percentage for any county or municipal corporation property tax may not exceed 110% for any taxable year.

The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, at a regular meeting on March 28, 2006, having considered said above requirements and desiring to comply with the Annotated Code of Maryland, does hereby set by resolution the homestead property tax credit for Washington County, Maryland.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, as follows:


1. In accordance with Section 9-105, Tax-Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the homestead credit percentage for the taxable year beginning July 1, 2007 shall be 105%.

2. Be it resolved that this Resolution shall become effective July 1, 2007.
