

RESOLUTION NO. RS-07-010
TO ABANDON AND CLOSE A PORTION OF POLECAT HOLLOW ROAD

A request was made by the Washington County Sportsman Club, Inc. to close and abandon a portion of a road located in Washington County, Maryland, known as Polecat Hollow Road (the "Road"), and is further shown on Exhibit A attached hereto.

In accordance with Article 25, Section 136, Annotated Code of Maryland, the County Commissioners may, on their own initiative, open, alter or close any County roads provided notice is duly given.

A public hearing was held on June 5, 2007 following due notice and advertisement of the request to abandon and close a portion of the Road.

Any public comment received was reviewed and carefully considered.


The portion of the Road to be abandoned and closed is approximately 2.4 miles long, has not been used by the County for a roadway, and it is no longer needed for a public purpose.

Washington County Sportsman Club, Inc. shall bear all costs and expenses associated with the abandonment and closing of the Road.




