

RESOLUTION NO. RS-08- 01

(Award of a contract for electronics recycling services for Washington County facilities from E-Structors, Inc. ("E-Structors") of Ellicott City, Maryland, under an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing arrangement with Allegany County, Maryland, pursuant to Section 1-106.3 of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland)

RECITALS

The Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland (the "Public Local Laws"), §1-106.3, provides that the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland (the "Board") "may procure goods and services through a contract entered into by another governmental entity in accordance with the terms of the contract, regardless of whether the county was a party to the original contract."

Subsection (c) of §1-106.3 provides that: "A determination to allow or participate in an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing arrangement under subsection (b) of this section shall be by resolution and shall either indicate that the participation will provide cost benefits to the county or result in administrative efficiencies and savings or provide other justifications for the arrangement."

Acquisition of the electronics recycling services by "piggy-backing" on a bid processed by Allegany County, Maryland and eliminating the Board's bid process would result in administrative efficiencies for Washington County. Using the Allegany County, Maryland contract award, the Board will be able to acquire from E-Structors the electronics recycling services at a fee rate of \$.039 per lb. if delivered by Washington County or \$.059 per lb. if serviced by E-Structors.

The Board expressly finds that entering into a contract with E-Structors to purchase the electronics recycling services would be in the best interests of the citizens of Washington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board, pursuant to §1-106.3, a contract is hereby awarded to E-Structors, Inc. of Ellicott City, Maryland for the purchase of electronics recycling services under an intergovernmental cooperative purchase of services arrangement with Allegany County, Maryland .




