

RESOLUTION No. RS-09-11

(Exemptions Related to Recordation Tax as Permitted Under Section 12-203 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland)

RECITALS

Md. Code, Tax-Property Article, §12-203 (the "Statute") provides that the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland (the "Board") has the authority to allow certain exemptions from the recordation tax provided for by the Statute.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, that:

1. Subject to the exemption amount noted below, there shall be an exemption for the buyer from the recordation tax in Washington County, Maryland on the conveyance of owner-occupied residential property if the buyer intends to use the property as the buyer's principal residence by actually occupying the residence for at least 7 months of a 12-month period.
2. The exemption shall be on the first \$200,000 of the consideration payable on the conveyance and on any purchase money mortgage or purchase money deed of trust related thereto.
3. This Resolution shall expire and shall be of no further force and effect on February 1, 2010 at 12:01 a.m., unless specifically extended by further act or resolution of the Board.


