# REVISED MEMO

TO: Washington County Licensed Electricians

FROM: Washington County Electrical Board

SUBJECT: Requirement for lettering business vehicles

---

The Washington County Electrical Board has amended the Rules and Regulations of Washington County to require Washington County Licensed Electricians to have their business vehicles lettered. The requirements for lettering the vehicles are as follows:

- Neither the company name nor the electrician's name is required to be displayed on the vehicle.
- Magnetic or other types of temporary signs are acceptable but must be displayed anytime the vehicle is on the jobsite.
- All vehicles must display the words "Licensed Electrician"
- The lettering must not be less than 1.5" in size
- All vehicles must display either the Washington County number, to include the assigned prefix (example – EL-M, or EL-R) OR you may elect to display your MD State license number. If you elect to display your state number, it must be preceded by the words "MD State"
- Personal vehicles used *in the performance of* electrical work in Washington County must meet the same requirements for business vehicles.
- A picture of a vehicle meeting the above requirements is required to accompany **any** new and/or renewal application except for the application/renewal of an inactive license.
