

INVITATION TO BID

The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, will accept sealed bids for the **PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE & REHABILITATION PROGRAM - FY-'10, HOT MIX ASPHALT (HMA) APPLICATIONS, CONTRACT NO. MS-PMP-133-28**. Bids will be received and time-stamped in the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, until **2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 6, 2009**. After which time they will be publicly opened in a conference room of the County Administrative Annex. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened.

The **PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE & REHABILITATION PROGRAM – FY-'10, HOT MIX ASPHALT (HMA) APPLICATIONS, CONTRACT NO. MS-PMP-133-28** project work is generally described as asphalt preservation and corrective practices including but not limited to: Crack Filling, Patching, Superpave Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Overlay, Concrete Mountable Curb Replacement, and Thermoplastic Pavement Markings. This work consists of: milling of existing bituminous concrete pavement, cleaning and sealing cracks, cleaning and tacking the existing pavement, adjustments of water valves, meters and manholes, placement of shoulder backup material, full and partial depth HMA patching, furnishing and installation of HMA Superpave surface and base, line striping, and pavement markings as described herein, inclusive of materials, labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work. All work on this project shall be done in accordance with the MSHA Specifications.

Copies of bid documents may be obtained from the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, (Telephone 240-313-2400), upon a **NON-REFUNDABLE** fee of **Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)** for each complete set. For mail requests, which must be made in writing, will require an **additional Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)** per set. All checks for bidding documents shall be made payable to the **Washington County Treasurer**.

Bidders must submit security in the form of cash, cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid; made payable to the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County Maryland. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Payment and Performance Bonds for the full amount of the Contract. Bids shall be executed on bid forms provided with the bidding documents in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

A Pre-Bid Conference for the project will be held **Monday, April 20, 2009 at 9:30 a.m.** in a conference room of the County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD. All prospective Bidders are encouraged to attend.

Washington County shall make positive efforts to utilize Disadvantaged Business Enterprises for its supplies and services and shall allow these sources the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts. The Board of County Commissioners does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age and disability in employment or the provision of services.
