

### INVITATION TO BID

The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, will accept sealed bids for the **BURNSIDE BRIDGE ROAD STREAM BANK STABILIZATION, CONTRACT NO. RD-BB-198-10**. Bids will be received and time-stamped in the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, until **11:00 A.M., WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 23, 2009**. After which time they will be publicly opened in a conference room of the County Administrative Annex. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. Inquiries regarding this bid should be directed to the County's Project Manager, **JESSICA SPRING** at telephone 240-313-2414, Fax 240-313-2401.

The **BURNSIDE BRIDGE ROAD STREAM BANK STABILIZATION** project work is generally described as **The project involves the stabilization of eroded stream banks along Antietam Creek south of Sharpsburg, Maryland. The work includes excavating and grading stream banks, removal of trees, placement of imbricated rip-rap and class II rip-rap, installation of traffic barriers, and embankment stabilization with grasses, live stakes, fascines, and trees.** All work on this project shall be done in accordance with the MSHA Specifications.

This project is to be financed through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) Maryland Department of the Environment (Grant), and includes the Affirmative Action Program Requirements and Goals, as well as the solicitation for Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) guided by certain Good Faith Efforts.

Copies of bid documents may be obtained from the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, (Telephone 240-313-2400), upon a **NON-REFUNDABLE fee of THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00)** for each complete set. For mail requests, which must be made in writing, will require an **additional TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00)** per set. All checks for bidding documents shall be made payable to the **Washington County Treasurer**.

Bidders must submit security in the form of cash, cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid; made payable to the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County Maryland. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Payment and Performance Bonds for the full amount of the Contract. Bids shall be executed on bid forms provided with the bidding documents in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

A Pre-Bid Conference for the project will be held **WEDNESDAY AUGUST 26, 2009 at 11:00 A.M** in a conference room of the County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD. All prospective Bidders are encouraged to attend.

Washington County shall make positive efforts to utilize Disadvantaged Business Enterprises for its supplies and services and shall allow these sources the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts. The Board of County Commissioners does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age and disability in employment or the provision of services.
