Separately sealed BIDS for the **SCALE HOUSE RELOCATION AND WHEEL WASH FACILITY** to generally include but not be limited to: placement of 2" water line, 4" sewer line, 2" conduits and pull boxes, septic tank and pump, scale house, wheel wash facility, excavation, clearing and grubbing, and paving and restoration as shown on contract plans will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland at the office of the Washington County Purchasing Department, Washington County Administration Building, 100 West Washington Street, Room 320, Hagerstown, MD 21740-4748 until no later than **2:00 P.M., (DST) Wednesday, February 22, 2012**, and then publicly opened and read aloud in the Second Floor Conference Room 255 of said building.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **Wednesday, February 1, 2012 at 10.30 A.M.**, prevailing time, at the Washington County Division of Environmental Management Public Meeting Room located at 16232 Elliott Parkway, Williamsport Maryland. Attendance at this Conference will not be mandatory for those contractors wishing to submit bids, but it is strongly encouraged.

Copies of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be purchased at the office of the Washington County Purchasing Department specified above upon payment of \$50.00 for each set. For mail request, which must be made in writing, an additional \$20 per set must be included. If contractor wishes to supply a Fed Ex or UPS account number in lieu of the additional mailing fee, this is acceptable. All checks for bid documents shall be made payable to the Washington County Treasurer. Payment must be received before the copies can be mailed.

Bid Security in the form of a Cashier's Check, Certified Check, or Bid Bond payable to the Board of County Commissioners, Washington County Maryland, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the Bid Price shall be submitted by each bidding Contractor. The successful bidder is required to furnish satisfactory Payment and Performance Bonds for the full amount of the Contract. Bids shall be properly and completely executed on bid forms (BID FORM) provided with the bid documents in accordance with the "Information for Bidders". All work shall conform to the drawings and specifications. The contractor shall use the Schedule of Prices forms from the Bid Documents to submit their pricing.

The Owner may make such investigations as deemed necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and prospective bidders shall be required to furnish to the Owner's representative evidence of performance of similar projects of this magnitude and complication and all such information and data for this purpose as may be requested. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligation of the Contract and to complete the work contemplated therein.

Washington County makes positive efforts to utilize Disadvantaged Business Enterprises for its supplies and services and allows these sources the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts.
