





REGISTRATION FORM

1. Pick program(s) you are interested in and note the registration number.

2. Complete the registration form in the rec guide. Every form must be signed by participant or parent/guardian if under 18 years of age.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Webtrac is the Washington County Recreation Department's online registration system. This software provides our customers with an additional method of registering for most programs. Those with internet access can view program availability, register for programs, and view their program history 24 hours a day! You must open an online registration account by visiting www.washcorecfit.com . You will be required to select a username and password for your family/household. Once registered on Webtrac, you can "shop" for activity enrollment by selecting your programs, placing them in your shopping cart, and checking out using a Visa, Mastercard or Discover to complete your transaction on our secured site. Upon completion of event registration you will be issued an e-mail receipt and notification. You must make complete payment at time of registration. Partial payments will not be accepted. If you need assistance with online registration you may call the Washington County Recreation Department Office at 240-313-2805. PAYMENT

FEE STRUCTURE

REFUND POLICY
