It is hoped that this award will enhance awareness for excellence in agriculture for Washington County, as well as to create an improved awareness and understanding of the problems faced by today's family farm business.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must operate a farm or agricultural business primarily located in Washington County, Maryland
- The farm business must generate a gross income of \$2,500 or more

All past applicants are encouraged to re-apply for this prestigious award. Judging will be held in September. The Farm of the Year winner will be announced at the Washington County Board of County Commissioners Meeting Tuesday, October 13, 2026, and celebrated at the Washington County Farm Bureau Annual Banquet on Friday October 16, 2026, at 6 pm. Winner will also receive a farm photo shoot, custom farm Carhartt jackets (up to 4), and to be used in County promotional materials throughout the year.
