Domestic Violence



Domestic Violence is any form of threat, control, or violence against an intimate partner

Facts

- 1 in 4 women and 1 in 33 men experience domestic violence
- 2,340 deaths in 2007 as a result of domestic violence
- In Maryland in 2006 2,083 domestic violence cases where filed
- Between July 2006 and June 2007 22 woman and 13 children were killed in a domestic violence situation

What to do about it

- Seek police assistance
- File a protective order
