Dear Consulting Parties:

Following receipt of comments from consulting parties and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, our office is providing this update to all consulting parties regarding the proposed ICE detention center at 10900 Hopewell Road in Hagerstown, Maryland (also known as 16220 Wright Road, Williamsport, MD 21795).

ICE has received a request for additional information from one tribe as part of this undertaking. ICE is currently awaiting final design from ICE's contractor to provide further ground disturbance information. Upon receipt of that information, ICE will be re-engaging with said tribe in compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Should the scope of the proposed undertaking change during final design, ICE will re-engage with all consulting parties at that time.

As part of ICE's National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) compliance, ICE has determined that the scope of potential impacts associated with the proposed undertaking warrants the development of an Environmental Assessment (EA). Public engagement on potential impacts to environmental and cultural resources will be initiated in the future. At that time, consulting parties will be afforded the opportunity to provide comments on potential impacts associated with the Proposed Action as part of the NEPA process. Once available, consulting parties will find this information available on [Documents for Public Comment | Homeland Security](#). All responses provided as part of Section 106 consultation will be considered for incorporation into the EA.
