

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-2020-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF AN EASEMENT INTEREST
IN REAL PROPERTY**

(Maugansville Capacity Project: South side of Salem Church Road, Hagerstown, Maryland)

RECITALS

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland (the "County"), believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Washington County to purchase an easement interest in certain real property identified on the attached Schedule A (the "Easement Property") to be used for public purposes.
2. The County approved the purchase of the Easement Property on April 16, 2020.
3. A public hearing was not required by Section 1-301, Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland, as the funds utilized to purchase the Easement Property are not to be expended from the General Fund of the County.
4. The purchase of the Easement Property is necessary for the Maugansville Capacity Project.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, that the purchase of the Easement Property be approved and that the President of the Board and the County Clerk be and are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, all such documents for and on behalf of the County relating to the purchase of the Easement Property.



SCHEDULE A--DESCRIPTION OF EASEMENT PROPERTY

EASEMENT PROPERTY ACQUISITION (Perpetual Utility Easement):

Part of Tax ID No. 13-004749; Tax Map 37, Parcel 777; South Side of Salem Church Road, Hagerstown, MD 21740

All that parcel of land consisting of 19,797 square feet or .45 acre, more or less, situate along the south side of Salem Church Road, and being more particularly described in accordance with a survey to be completed by Frederick Seibert and Associates, Inc., and intended to be recorded among the Land Records of Washington County, Maryland.

Said easement crossing the lands conveyed by Esther L. Eby, widow, to Henry S. Eby and Miriam K. Eby, by deed dated December 18, 1974, recorded among the Land Records of Washington County, Maryland, in Liber 0589, folio 0079.
