(Not to exceed 50% occupancy)

(Not to exceed 50% occupancy)

- Florists • Furniture stores • Jewelers
- Lawn & garden stores • Pawn shops • Pet groomers
- Sporting good stores • Tobacco & vape shops

### MANUFACTURING

### BEAUTY SALONS & BARBER SHOPS

(Not to exceed 50% occupancy)

- Appointment only

### LANDFILL

### OUTDOOR RECREATION

- Golf courses & driving range
- Outdoor archery & shooting ranges
- Marinas & watercraft rental businesses
- Campgrounds • Horse boarding & riding facilities
  - County parks and dog parks
  - Sports fields and courts
- Drive-in movie theaters • Outdoor swimming pools
  - Outdoor day camps • Tour boats

### RESTAURANTS, BARS & SOCIAL CLUBS

(Carryout, delivery, curbside and outdoor dining only)

- Staff required to wear face coverings
- Patrons must be seated at least 6 ft. apart
- Only 6 per table, exception of same household
- No buffets • Clean each table between seatings
- Social/fraternal clubs can open for food operations

- Self-defense schools

- Bingo halls • Bowling alleys • Pool Halls
- Amusement parks • Roller and ice skating rinks
- Miniature golf establishments • Social Clubs

- Nail salons • Esthetic services
