ITEM NO. 2: <u>Inquiry</u>: Regarding the above referenced job, the drawings specify that on all three sides of the opening, steel be installed on both inside and out with through bolting at several points. Is the existing substrate hollow CMU? In past jobs, we have encountered the same spec, and the drilling to provide the through bolts has broken the CMU enough that the steel had nothing left to rest on. This caused substantial delays while the engineers worked the problem.

<u>Response:</u> The County is unable to verify that the existing substrate is hollow CMU.
