## **RESOLUTION NO. RS-2016-13**

(Award of a contract for Purchasing Card (PCard) Program Services ("PCard Services") for use by Washington County Departments from JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. under an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing arrangement with Fairfax County, Virginia, pursuant to Section 1-106.3 of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland)

## **RECITALS**

The Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland (the "Public Local Laws"), §1-106.3, provides that the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland (the "Board") "may procure goods and services through a contract entered into by another governmental entity in accordance with the terms of the contract, regardless of whether the county was a party to the original contract."

Subsection (c) of §1-106.3 provides that: "A determination to allow or participate in an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing arrangement under subsection (b) of this section shall be by resolution and shall either indicate that the participation will provide cost benefits to the county or result in administrative efficiencies and savings or provide other justifications for the arrangement."

Acquisition of the PCard Services by "piggy-backing" on a bid processed by Fairfax County, Virginia and using the Fairfax County, Virginia contract award, the County would be eligible for a percentage rebate based on the annual combined charge volume and average fileturn tier contained in the contract.

The Board expressly finds that entering into a contract with JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. to purchase the PCard Services would be in the best interest of the citizens of Washington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board, pursuant to §1-106.3, a contract is hereby awarded to JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. for the purchase of PCard Services under an intergovernmental cooperative purchase of services arrangement with Fairfax County, Virginia.
