RESOLUTION NO. RS-2017-21

RESOLUTION TO ABANDON A PORTION OF A COUNTY ROAD PART OF BOTTENFIELD ROAD, HANCOCK, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MARYLAND

A request was made to the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland (the "Board") by Valley Meadow Farms, LLC to abandon a portion of Bottenfield Road (the "Road") consisting of 2,636.55 linear feet which runs through its property.

In accordance with Md. Code, <u>Local Government Article</u>, Sections 12-504 and 12-512, the County Commissioners may, on their own initiative, open, alter or close any county roads provided notice is duly given and a hearing granted.

A public hearing was held on October 17, 2017 following due notice and advertisement of the request to abandon the Road.

Any public comment received was reviewed and carefully considered.

The portion of the Road to be closed and abandoned would begin approximately 0.6 miles from its intersection with Mountain Road in a northerly direction to the Maryland/Pennsylvania State Line.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, that, in accordance with Md. Code, <u>Local Government Article</u>, Sections 12-504 and 12-512, the portion of the Road consisting of 2,636.55 linear feet, more or less, as more particularly shown on Attachment A, shall be abandoned and closed.
