RESOLUTION NO. RS-2021-13

SETTING THE INCOME TAX RATE FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY, MARYLAND

Recitals

Md. Code, <u>Tax-General</u>, §10-106 provides that each county may set a county income tax equal to at least 1% but not more than 3.20% of an individual's Maryland taxable income for a tax year beginning after December 31, 2001.

The Board of County Commissioners has determined that it would be in the best interests of the citizens of Washington County to reduce the county income tax rate from 3.2% to 3.0% for all taxable years, beginning on January 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, MARYLAND, that a county income tax is imposed at a rate of 3.0% for all taxable years, beginning on January 1, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that notice be given to the Comptroller of the above rate reduction on or before July 1, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. RS-2019-15, adopted June 4, 2019, setting the county income tax rate at 3.2% is repealed and of no further force or effect as of 11:59:59 P.M., December 31, 2021.
