

INDUSTRIAL DISCHARGE PERMITS

The Division of Environmental Management provides guidance and oversight to the nine (9) county-owned facilities that have a [General Permit for Discharges of Stormwater Associated with Industrial Activity \(20-SW\)](#), as required by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE).

Under this permit, the facilities are recognized to have the potential to contribute to stormwater pollution. However, they have committed to identifying potential sources and implementing proper control measures in order to limit the amount of exposure from their sources through a ***Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan*** (SWPPP).

As such, each facility (unless designated as Inactive & Unstaffed) is required to inspect their facilities and operations four times per year to properly evaluate the control measures identified in the SWPPP. Should their control measures fail, they are held accountable by the State to clean up any spills or discharges and correct them such that an incident does not occur again.

VEHICLE WASHING PERMITS

The Division of Environmental Management provides guidance and oversight to the nine (9) county-owned facilities that have a [*General Permit for the Discharge of Exterior Washwater to Groundwater from Commercial and Business-Related Vehicle Washing Operations \(21VW\)*](#), as required by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE).

Under this permit, the facilities are recognized to have the potential to contribute to stormwater pollution. Washing areas were chosen to allow washwater to runoff onto grassy areas where the water will soak in and not affect surface waters or stormwater. All facilities owned by Washington County are considered Use Class I.

Each facility is required to keep a monthly logbook of use and maintenance to the vehicle washing area. MSDS sheets are also kept onsite for cleaners used, which have been approved by MDE. Should their control measures fail, they are held accountable by the State to clean up any spills or discharges and correct them such that an incident does not occur again.
