## WASHINGTON COUNTY GAMING COMMISSION ANNOUNCES GAMING FUND DISTRIBUTION

Hagerstown, MD (August 9, 2011) -- The Washington County Gaming Commission announced its gaming fund distribution to the Washington County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, as well as 98 local charitable organizations.

The Gaming Fund total of \$1,897,369.42 for fiscal year 2011, which ended June 30<sup>th</sup>, represents a 5.61% decrease when compared to fiscal year 2010 revenues.

State law provides for funds to be divided equally between the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association and local charities.

In January, the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association received \$414,398.08. With today's announcement, an additional \$534,286.63 will be distributed, bringing the yearly total for Fire and Rescue to \$948,684.71.

In May, the Washington County Gaming Commission received 127 separate applications from 107 charitable organizations requesting a total of \$2,715,754.50.

After a one-day workshop in June, and two days of public hearings in July, the Commission was able to either partially or fully fund 106 of the 127 requests. Of the 127 applications received, 16 received full funding, 90 received partial funding, and 21 were denied funding. A total of \$948,684.71 was allocated to 98 of the 107 charitable organizations applying.

The Regional Community Health Center (Community Free Clinic) received the largest award of \$175,000, followed by REACH Caregivers receiving \$70,000, and Friends of Safe Place, Child Advocacy Center, which received \$64,740.00.

The Washington County Gaming Commission is a volunteer 7-member board appointed by the County Delegation and County Commissioners. Established by the State Legislature in 1995, the Commission is responsible to ensure the revenue produced by Tip Jars played in the county's clubs, taverns, liquor stores, and restaurants is equitably distributed. Since its beginning, the Commission has provided over 45 million dollars to charities and fire and rescue companies in Washington County.
