GAMING COMMISSION AWARDS OVER \$1.9 MILLION IN ALLOCATIONS

Hagerstown, Md. (August 6, 2013) – The Washington County Gaming Commission announced its gaming fund distribution to the Washington County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, as well as 99 local charitable organizations.

In January, the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association received \$404,900.00 in gaming funds. As a result of today's announcement, Fire and Rescue will receive an additional \$545,229.54 bringing the association's yearly to \$950,129.54.

In May, the Washington County Gaming Commission received 119 separate applications from 105 charitable organizations requesting a total of \$2,475,057.88.

After a one-day workshop in June, and two days of public hearings in July, the Commission was able to either partially or fully fund 107 of the 119 requests. Of the 119 applications received, 20 received full funding, 87 received partial funding, and 12 were denied funding. A total of \$950,129.55 was allocated to 99 of the 105 charitable organizations applying.

The Community Free Clinic received the largest award of \$175,000 followed by Safe Place Child Advocacy Center, which received \$64,740.

The Gaming Fund totaled \$1,900,259.09 for fiscal year 2013, which ended June 30, represents a 2.23% increase versus fiscal year 2012 revenues. State law requires funds to be divided equally between the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association and local charities.

Since the funds distributed do not come from the County's general fund, it allows the County to assist the numerous non-profits without impacting tax payers.
