### **GAMING COMMISSION AWARDS OVER \$1.9 MILLION IN ALLOCATIONS**

HAGERSTOWN, MD (July 26, 2016) - The Washington County Gaming Commission is proud to announce its gaming fund distribution to the Washington County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, as well as 78 local charitable organizations.

The Gaming Fund total of \$1,984,918.12 for fiscal year 2016, which ended June 30<sup>th</sup>, represents an increase of \$15,185.90 when compared to fiscal year 2015 revenues.

State law requires funds be divided equally between the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association and local charities, and in January the Washington County Fire and Rescue Association received \$435,886. As of today, an additional \$556,573.06 will be distributed, bringing the yearly total for Fire and Rescue to \$992,459.06.

In May, the Washington County Gaming Commission received 100 separate applications from 84 charitable organizations requesting a total of \$2,265,080.94. After a one-day workshop in June, and public hearings in July, the Commission was able to either partially or fully fund 87 of the 100 requests. Of the 100 applications received, 13 received full funding, 74 received partial funding, and 13 were denied funding. A total of \$992,459.06 was allocated to 78 of the 84 charitable organizations applying.

The Community Free Clinic received the largest award of \$168,000, followed by Safe Place Child Advocacy Center and R.E.A.C.H, which both received \$60,000.
