Each vendor is required to provide a sample of their product; Businesses providing food samples must complete The Washington County Health Department Permit to Operate a Special Temporary Food Service Facility form attached/emailed to you and bring the certificate with you to the Groundhog Day event or provided it via email in advance.
- 4. Wineries, breweries, and distilleries need TAM certificate for at least one employee present at the event.
- 5. For wineries, breweries and distilleries please complete your off- permit sales license using our Washington County Liquor License number 20201888.

#### Key information:

- 1. All guests will be required to show a valid ID at the entrance. Guests who are 21 and over will receive a wristband indicating they are of legal drinking age, which will allow them to sample and purchase alcohol.
- 2. Last call for alcohol will be at 8:30.
- 3. Vendor space assignment has been determined in advance.
- 4. Snow Date is Friday, February 6, 2026.
- 5. In the event of poor weather conditions, a decision will be made by 10am on Friday January 30, 2026.
