This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents on which all bids will be based and is issued to correct and clarify the original documents.

Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum at the appropriate space on the Proposal Form. This Addendum consists of four (4) pages, the Pre-Bid Conference Sign Sheets (ATTACHMENT NO. 1), three (3) Revised Drawing sheets (ATTACHMENT NO. 2), and the *Revised* Form of Proposal/Schedule of Prices consisting of twenty-three (23) pages (ATTACHMENT NO, 3).

<u>NOTE</u>: All bidders <u>must</u> enter the County Administration Building through the front door, 100 West Washington Street entrance, and <u>must</u> use the elevator to access the Purchasing Department to submit their bid. Alternate routes are now controlled by a door access system.

ITEM NO. 1: *Inquiry*: What is the estimated cost of the project?

Response: The engineer's estimate is \$2.85 M

ITEM NO. 2: <u>*Inquiry*</u>: Can you send me a copy of the sign in sheet from the Pre-Bid Conference?

ITEM NO. 4: <u>*Inquiry*</u>: Are all millings from the project to go to the area just south of the existing parking lot at the terminal?

<u>Response</u>: No, just the volume of millings required to construct the area south of the existing parking lot (6,300 SY @ 6" DEPTH). Any remaining/additional millings or demolished pavement shall be disposed of legally, off-site.

ITEM NO. 5: <u>*Inquiry*</u>: Does the airport have an area to waste or stockpile all excess excavation materials, pavement removal & unclassified excavation?

<u>Response</u>: An area on the airport will be provided for any suitable material (as determined by engineer). Unsuitable material (pavement removal, debris, unsuitable soils) shall be disposed of legally, off-site.

ITEM NO. 6: <u>Inquiry</u>: When runway 9/27 is to be closed and 4 runway closure markers are required, will the Airport provide, set-up, and remove the 2 additional markers required above the 2 in the bid?

Response: The second set is addressed in this addendum.

Lighted closure markers shall meet the requirements as stated in the FAA Advisory Circulars 150/5345-53D and 150/5345-55A. The contractor shall also supply and maintain a second set of temporary runway closure markers meeting the details included in the plans. Closure markers shall become the property of the owner upon project completion.

Transport/setup, maintenance and removal of the lighted runway closure markers as required by the drawings and specifications shall be the responsibility of the contractor during the execution of the contract and shall be incidental to the items that require them.

ITEM NO. 15: <u>Specification Revision – Section 105:</u>

Delete section 105-2.2 and replace with the following:

105-2.2 Procurement of runway closure markers shall be paid based upon the contract lump sum price for "Supply (2) FAA Approved Lighted and (2) Unlighted Runway Closure Markers".

Revise pay item 105-2.2 to read: "Supply (2) FAA Approved Lighted and (2) Unlighted Runway Closure Markers"



GENERAL PHASING NOTES:

- 1. THE INTENT OF THE PHASING PLAN IS TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT OF CONSTRUCTION ON THE OPERATION OF THE AIRPORT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONSTRUCT THE PROJECT AS OUTLINED IN THE PLANS UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER. ADJUSTMENTS TO THE PHASING PLAN MAY BE NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE UNFORESEEN PROBLEMS WITH AIRPORT OPERATION.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE, MAINTAIN, MOVE, REMOVE (AS DIRECTED) CONSTRUCTION BARRIERS TO DELINEATE AREAS CLOSED TO AIRCRAFT TRAFFIC AND TO MARK ALL OPEN EXCAVATIONS, PAVEMENT DROP-OFFS ETC.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO STARTING CONSTRUCTION. STRICT ADHERENCE TO THE APPROVED SCHEDULE WILL BE ENFORCED TO AVOID CONFLICTS WITH OTHER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES AND ADVERSE EFFECTS ON AIRPORT OPERATIONS.
- 4. ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL BE SEQUENCED TO MAINTAIN ALL ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS WITHOUT ANY INTERRUPTIONS. TEMPORARY WIRING IF REQUIRED SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE CORRESPONDING ELECTRICAL. ALL ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE ENGINEER AND THE AIRPORT MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT.
- 5. EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL DEVICES MUST BE IN PLACE PRIOR TO THE START OF GRADING OPERATIONS. 6. ACTIVE PAVEMENTS MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AND FREE OF DEBRIS AT ALL TIMES. THE CONTRACTOR MUST HAVE A VACUUM SWEEPER AND OPERATOR READY AT ALL TIMES
- DURING WORK ADJACENT TO ACTIVE AIRFIELD PAVEMENTS.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR MUST COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE FAA ADVISORY CIRCULARS AND FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS. PAY PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO FAA AC 150/5370-2F.
- 8. MAXIMUM EQUIPMENT HEIGHTS FOR ACTIVE WORK AREAS AND STAGING AREA ARE LIMITED BY FAR PART 77 AND OBSTACLE FREE ZONE (OFZ) SURFACES IDENTIFIED ON THIS SHEET
- 9. DUST ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IS A MAJOR PROBLEM. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DUST CONTROL ON-SITE AT ALL TIMES ON A CONTINUOUS BASIS. THE CONTRACTOR MUST SUBMIT A DETAILED DUST CONTROL PLAN TO THE ENGINEER FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK. THE COST FOR THIS WORK SHALL BE INCLUDED UNDER VARIOUS CONTRACT ITEMS.

SUPERVISION:

THE PRIME CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE THE PROJECT SUPERINTENDENT OR SOMEONE IN RESPONSIBLE CHARGE BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES ON THE PROJECT SITE. THIS PERSON SHALL BE FAMILIAR WITH ALL TYPES OF CONSTRUCTION BEING PERFORMED AND SHALL BE THE SAME PERSON EACH DAY THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT. THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COORDINATING EACH DAY'S WORK WITH THE ENGINEER AND AIRPORT PERSONNEL AND SHALL HAVE AUTHORITY TO SCHEDULE AND ADJUST ALL WORKERS, PRIME AND SUB CONTRACTORS, TO ACCOMMODATE AIRPORT OPERATION AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER AND/OR AIRPORT PERSONNEL.

ALL WORK MUST BE PERFORMED WITH THE ENGINEER AND/OR AIRPORT PERSONNEL ON THE SITE. WORK DURING EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS MUST BE COORDINATED WITH THE ENGINEER AND AIRPORT PERSONNEL AT LEAST 7 DAYS IN ADVANCE, EXCLUDING EMERGENCIES AND INCLEMENT WEATHER CONDITIONS. ALL PERSONNEL SHALL CLEAR THE CONSTRUCTION AREA ONCE WORK HAS STOPPED FOR THE DAY. ALL MECHANICS NEEDING ACCESS TO THE AIR OPERATIONS AREA DURING EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS TO WORK ON CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL HAVE A PICTURED IDENTIFICATION BADGE, RECEIVE DRIVING PRIVILEGES, AND HAVE THEIR VEHICLES IDENTIFIED WITH THE CONTRACTOR NAME OR MAGNETIC PLACARD ISSUED BY THE AIRPORT OPERATIONS.



- 2. A SIGN FACE IS DEFINED AS A SEQUENCE OF NUMBERS, LETTERS, ARROWS, OR "BLANKS" ON ONE SIDE OF A SIGN WHICH CONVEY A MESSAGE. A BLANK PANEL IS AN ALL BLACK PANEL.
- 3. 'APPROXIMATE STATIONS' ON THE SIGN SCHEDULE ARE TO ASSIST THE CONTRACTOR IN DETERMINING THE GENERAL AREA FOR WHICH THE SIGN WOULD BE PLACED. VARYING FROM THE 'APPROXIMATE STATIONS' BY MORE THEN 2-FEET SHALL REQUIRE COORDINATION AND APPROVAL BY THE ENGINEER.

TAPE SHALL NOT BE APPLIED DIRECTLY TO ANY SURFACE OF THE NEW SIGN. COVER MATERIAL SHALL BE SECURED TO THE SIGN AND WITHSTAND MOVEMENT AND UNVEILING BY WIND OR 200 MPH JET BLAST. ANY SHIFTING OR MOVEMENT OF THE COVER SHALL BE CORRECTED IMMEDIATELY BY THE CONTRACTOR. GUIDANCE SIGN COVERS SHALL BE BLACK, HIGH DENSITY POLYETHYLENE (HPDE) SHEETING, MINIMUM 10 MIL, COVERS SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH EYELETS TO ACCOMMODATE ROPE FOR SECURING THE SIGN COVERS. COST OF SIGN COVERS SHALL BE INCIDENTAL APPLICABLE SIGN ITEM.
- 6. SIGNS SHALL BE COVERED AS REQUIRED TO ACCOMODATE AIRPORT OPERATION AND CONSTRUCTION PHASING.
