This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents on which all bids will be based and is issued to correct and clarify the original documents.

Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum at the appropriate space on the Proposal Form. This Addendum consists of four (4) pages and one (1) attachment **Revised** Form of Proposal consisting of twenty-five (25) pages.

NOTE: All bidders <u>must</u> enter the County Administration Building through the front door, 100 West Washington Street entrance, and <u>must</u> use the elevator to access the Purchasing Department to submit their bid. Alternate routes are now controlled by a door access system.

ITEM NO. 1: <u>Inquiry</u>: At the pre-bid meeting it was stated that, in addition to the overall DBE goal of 3.25%, there are separate sub-goals for women and minority participation. Would you confirm if sub-goals are required and if so please direct me to where I can find this in the bid documents?

**Response:** No sub-goals are required in this contract. Minority and female participation goals for contractor work force shall conform to the requirements listed in Section IV, page F-15.

ITEM NO. 2: <u>Inquiry</u>: Section P156, paragraph 2.2E specifies 95% ASTM D1557 (modified proctor) for compaction under paved areas. Paragraph 2.6 specifies 95% ASTM D698 (standard proctor) under paved areas. Please clarify which is correct.

(NOTE: The wording of all "Inquiries" submitted are displayed exactly as received.)

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**<u>Response:</u>** We believe the bidder question is related to Section P-152 (not P-156). Paragraph 2.6 shall be revised to ASTM D1557. Revision will be included with conformed documents.

**ITEM NO. 3:** <u>Inquiry</u>: What type of curb is required for Bid Item MD-602-3.1? Please provide detail(s) if possible.

**Response:** The curb shall match existing curb dimensions/profile. The existing curb is 6" wide at the top, 9" wide at the base and 18" in height.

**ITEM NO. 4:** <u>Inquiry</u>: What type of reflective sheeting is required for permanent signs? Refer to MD SHA Specification 950.03.

**Response:** Type III.

**ITEM NO. 5:** <u>Inquiry</u>: Plan C13.01 does not provide dimensions for signs, many of which are custom. What are the sizes?

**Response:** The method of measurement and basis of measurement for signs has been revised to square feet in lieu of each. The quantity has been revised to **400**. The non-standard signage dimensions shall be field verified by contractor prior to submitting shop drawings for review.

**ITEM NO. 6:** <u>Inquiry</u>: Note 2 on C8.04 calls for the contractor to provide a paving plan/model for review and approval. Is this strictly to show positive drainage will be accomplished during the milling and overlay process? Please clarify intent.

**Response:** Positive drainage is the intent.

**ITEM NO. 7:** <u>Inquiry</u>: Detail 2/C6.08 calls for a SHA curb. Please clarify if this is to be a header curb or provide a specific detail.

**Response:** See response to item 3 above.

ITEM NO. 8: <u>Inquiry</u>: Plan C12.01 shows Borings B-1 thru B-11 but C12.02 & C12.03 only show the reports thru B-9. Please provide B-10 & B-11.

**<u>Response</u>**: Only cores were done at those locations. 6" of HMA on 8" Cement Treated Base.

**ITEM NO. 9:** <u>Inquiry</u>: Plan C12.01 – Can the Historical Boring Reports be provided since we are responsible for any paving and stone base damage due to the truck operation to perform our work? We need to know if there are any soft areas.

**<u>Response</u>**: Any damage due to soft areas will be considered additional work and will be dealt with accordingly.

# **ITEM NO. 10:** <u>Inquiry</u>: C4.01 – General Construction Notes Line Item # 7 references a specification section x-6 that addresses temporary construction items. Please provide or clarify the location in the documents.

**<u>Response:</u>** Delete the reference to "specification section X-6". Add the following sentence. Any temporary work not assigned its own unit price required to complete the project shall be considered incidental to the item for which it is required and included in the cost of unit priced items.

ITEM NO. 11: <u>Inquiry</u>: C4.01 – General Construction Note Line Item # 11 states that the FAA may elect to have damaged FAA cables repaired by others in lieu of our electrician and we have to incur this cost. What would be the factors that would cause the FAA to make this decision and can you provide the wage rates that this labor would be based on?

**<u>Response:</u>** No impacts to FAA facilities are anticipated in this contract. For the purpose of bidding, assume that the contractor will be allowed to make repairs to any damaged FAA cables.

#### ITEM NO. 12: Drawing Revision - Sheet C2.01 Quantity Sheet and Earthwork Table:

**Revise** unit and quantity for MD-813.2 from EA to **SF** and from 60 to **400**. Revised drawing will be reissued with conformed set.

#### ITEM NO. 13: <u>Drawing Revision - Sheet C4.01 General Construction and Safety Notes:</u>

Note 2: **Add** sentence "The contractor will be required to submit a safety plan compliance document (SPCD) that outlines how the contractor intends to comply with the established construction safety phasing plan (CSPP) requirements in accordance with FAA AC 150/5370-2F.

Note 8: **Revise** reference from X-5 to Item 105.

#### ITEM NO. 14: <u>Specification Revision – Section 813</u>:

**Delete** section 813-3 and replace with the following:

813-3 Payment will be made at the contract unit price per each post and per square foot for sign face.

These prices shall fully compensate the Contractor for furnishing all materials and for all preparation and installation of these materials; and for all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the item, including field verification and shop drawing preparation. Cost shall include all requirements including finishing, demolition, hardware, excavation, etc.
