**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move to award the Contract Services at Transfer Stations and On-Site at the Forty West Landfill to responsive, responsible, bidder Apple Valley Waste of Maryland of Kearneysville, WV based on the Total Sum Bid (Transfer Station Location Nos. 1 through 5) \$312,550.00, plus Alternate No.1 (cardboard transports at Forty West) \$6,000.00 for a Total Amount of \$318,550.00.

**REPORT-IN-BRIEF:** On June 13, 2018, the County accepted bids for the Contract Services at the Transfer Stations and On-Site at Forty West Landfill. The Invitation to Bid (ITB) was advertised in the local newspaper, listed on the State's "*eMaryland Marketplace*" website and the County's website. Thirteen (13) persons/companies registered downloaded the bid document online. Two (2) bids were received as indicated on the attached bid tabulation matrix.

The contract is for a one (1) year period, tentatively beginning August 1, 2018 with an option by the County to renew for up to three (2) additional consecutive one (1) periods, subject to written notice given by the County at least sixty (60) calendar days in advance of its expiration. The County guarantees neither a maximum/minimum of transports from each location under this contract.
