This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents on which all bids will be based and is issued to correct and clarify the original documents.

Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum at the appropriate space on the Proposal Form. This Addendum consists of seven (7) pages and eight (8) attachments.

NOTE: Washington County government has limited access to the Washington County Administration Complex at 100 West Washington Street, Hagerstown, Maryland until further notice. All Bidders shall allow ample time for delivery of their bid packets. Delivery of bid packets via-courier service or United States Postal Service (USPS) will be accepted. For those bidders who wish to deliver their bid packet in person will need to call 240-313-2330 to schedule an appointment.

- ITEM NO. 1: All reference in the bid document made to the submittal deadline have been extended to no later than 2:00 P.M., Friday, September 18, 2020.
- ITEM NO. 2: All reference in the bid document to the submittal of Subcontractor's List have been extended to no later than 2:00 P.M., Monday, September 21, 2020.
- ITEM NO. 3: <u>Inquiry</u>: Per Spec Section 064023, section 2, paragraph 2.1, Northern Hard Maple plain-sawn or sliced is called for. Section 1.2.A includes the custom cabinets and millwork for the reception desk in this specification section. However, the elevations on Drawing I4.6 show plastic laminate cabinetry and panels, topped with quartz countertops. There is no detail showing wood or wood veneer. Please confirm that the custom reception desk is to be plastic-laminate with quartz countertops.

<u>Response</u>: The custom reception desk is to be plastic laminate with quartz countertops. Running trim to be used for Tackboard Trim. See ITEM NO. 10 in this Addendum.

ITEM NO. 4:

<u>Inquiry</u>: Will Washington Co. Purchasing Dept. be revising the bid form page 005000-7 in the Corporate Principal signature block area so it is clear as to where exactly the Corporate Officer, such as President/V.P., signs as you have a line space for the Corp. Secretary to sign in what appears to be the main signature area where the President of the Corporation should sign. Addendum 5 states not to change the form and that only 1 officer is required to sign, but this signature block is confusing as to where exactly the President should sign. (It appears the Corporate Principal signature block spacing is askew, compared to the Individual and Co-Partnership areas.)

Response: See Attachment "H" to this Addendum.

ITEM NO. 5: <u>Inquiry</u>: It was stated in addendum #4 item #9 and item #13 that a substitution was accepted. It never provided what this substitution was and no attachment was present. Did we miss receiving an attachment?

<u>Response</u>: For ITEM NO. 9 in Addendum No. 4 substitutions were approved for the MRS System 2500 double locked and mechanically seamed standing seam metal roofing system and MRS Flush-Seam concealed fastener, lap-seam metal soffit panels. Approved substitution to meet all requirements of the specified product.

For ITEM NO. 14 in Addendum No. 4 a substitution was approved for resinous flooring products manufactured by Florock as long as the custom color flake blend is met as indicated in the specification.

 - 5. Panel Size: 4 feet by 8 feet. Thickness/ R-Value based on ASTM C 518 at 75 degrees F: 3.1 inches/ R-Value 16.1 with 5/8-inch plywood facing.

Air/Vapor Barrier (installed over Gypsum Sheathing): Continuous single component, asphalt free, fluid applied vapor permeable self-sealing elastomeric air barrier membrane which permit moisture vapor to escape through the membrane while remaining resistant to water and air penetration ASTM E2178, ASTM E96 and ASTM E2357. Apply over exterior gypsum sheathing at 75 square foot (20 mils wet) per gallon. Must be compatible with contacted surfaces and materials including cavity insulation.

TYICAL WALL DETAIL AT CEMENT BOARD SIDING


