Thank you for the opportunity to submit a bid. Please find our remarks/exceptions below in the form of a proposed delivery section replacement.

Delivery:

- a. The successful Bidder shall deliver the Bulk Road Salt F.O.B. Destination to the locations listed herein. Deliveries shall begin within seventy-two to one hundred twenty (72-120) hours (3-5 business days) of request by the Highway department's personnel. The trucking firm shall notify delivery contact (via-telephone) of each upcoming delivery within twenty-four (24) hours of delivery. All questions and concerns should be directed to the Mid-Atlantic Salt sales office. All deliveries shall be inspected and accepted by authorized County personnel. A telephone number and contact for emergency and after-hour deliveries must be available twenty-four (24) hours a day Monday through Sunday. Normal hours of operation for the delivery locations are 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., (EDT/EST), Monday through Friday. All efforts will be made to arrange delivery during normal work hours; however, there will be no additional charge for emergency deliveries made after-hours. Deliveries will be made to seven (7) locations within Washington County, MD. The price per ton will include delivery regardless of the location listed herein.
- b. An order placed prior to 10:00 AM on any business day (Monday through Friday, except Holidays) would be considered as the first calendar day of the three to five (3-5) day delivery period. The jurisdiction shall reserve the right to take action to remedy the failure of Contractor performance only after verbal AND written notification of request to remedy the delay, an opportunity to remedy the delay, AND verbal AND written notification of the failure of any efforts to remedy the delay. This may include termination of the order and purchase of salt from other sources, or to take action consistent with public safety as needed to continue business. No additional costs or liquidated damage may be collected from the Contractor if delay or failure is outside of its control, such as delays incurred by severe weather.
