To Bidders:

This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents on which all proposals will be based and is issued to correct and clarify the original documents.

Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum at the appropriate space on the Proposal Form. This Addendum consists of two (2) pages.

NOTE: All Bidders must enter the Washington County Administration Complex through either the front door at the 100 West Washington Street entrance or through the rear entrance (w/blue canopy roof) which is handicap accessible and must use the elevator to access the Purchasing Department to submit their proposal and/or to attend the Pre-Proposal Conference. Alternate routes are controlled by a door access system. The general public will be subject to wand search and will be required to remove any unauthorized items from the building prior to entry. Prohibited items include but are not limited to: Weapons of any type; Firearms, ammunition, and explosive devices; Cutting instruments of any type - including knives, scissors, box cutters, work tools, knitting needles, or anything with a cutting edge, etc.; Pepper spray, mace or any other chemical defense sprays; and Illegal substances.

ITEM NO. 1: <u>Inquiry</u>: The County is offering site visits on Wednesday May 11th and Thursday May 12th. What is the schedule for these visits? How many sites will be visited? Are two full days required to visit the sites or can the visits be accomplished on one of the two days designated?

<u>Response</u>: Part 1 of Item No. 1 herein: Based on the geographic distance between all ten (10) county radio communications sites and two separate physical locations for our primary and back-up ECC's...we will be visiting six

(6) sites on Wednesday May 11th and six (6) sites on Thursday May 12th. We will allocate an hour per site visit with additional travel time in between, starting with Elliott Parkway moving to sites West on May 11th, and starting at 35 W. Washington Street and moving to sites East on May 12th.

<u>Response</u>: Part 2 of Item No. 1 herein: There are a total of twelve (12) sites to be visited; ten (10) Transfer Stations and two (2) ECC stations.

<u>Response</u>: Part 3 of Item No. 1 herein: Please see the response to Item No. 1 of this Addendum.

ITEM NO. 2: Inquiry: Is participation in the site visits required in order to submit a proposal?

<u>Response</u>: While we cannot exclude venders from submitting a proposal if not attending the site visits, it is highly recommended that potential bidders participate in the on-site visits.

ITEM NO. 3: <u>Inquiry</u>: Will the selected consultant still have the opportunity to visit sites during execution of the project?

<u>Response</u>: If the selected consultant is awarded the project, they will have the opportunity to visit any site as required to perform the RF coverage study or formulate any technical proposals. The winning bidder will not be able to increase their bid after any post bid site visit.

ITEM NO. 4: Inquiry: We request the County remove penalties for missed deliverables.

<u>Response</u>: We are not sure as to what section of the RFP document your question is referring to. Please resubmit your inquiry and be more specific with providing the page number, item number and description so that a response can be provided.
