This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Request for Quotation (RFQ) Documents on which all quotations will be based and is issued to correct and/or clarify the original documents.

Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum on the Quotation Form. This Addendum consists of two (2) pages.

NOTE: All Bidders must enter the Washington County Administration Complex through either the front door at the 100 West Washington Street entrance or through the rear entrance (w/blue canopy roof) which is handicap accessible and must use the elevator to access the Purchasing Department to submit their quotation and/or to attend the Pre-Quotation Conference. Alternate routes are controlled by a door access system. The general public will be subject to wand search and will be required to remove any unauthorized items from the building prior to entry. Prohibited items include but are not limited to: Weapons of any type; Firearms, ammunition, and explosive devices; Cutting instruments of any type - including knives, scissors, box cutters, work tools, knitting needles, or anything with a cutting edge, etc.; Pepper spray, mace or any other chemical defense sprays; and Illegal substances.

ITEM NO. 1: <u>Inquiry</u>: Please clarify #21 Substitutions/Samples states lines 6, 7, 8, 10.... No subs allowed. Should it be lines 7, 8, 9, 10... etc?

<u>Response</u>: Please refer to the Request for Quotation document Pεge 6, Item No. 21 Substitutions/Samples; **CHANGE** this paragraph to read as follows:

Any Quoter who contemplates offering a product that differs from that specified <u>MUST</u> obtain the County's written approval prior to quotation opening. Substitution samples (minimum ten (10) pairs of gloves, size - large) shall be received in the Purchasing Department no later than 4:00 P.M. (EDT/EST), Wednesday, July 6, 2022. Requests received after this deadline for substitutions may not be considered. All such decisions will be considered final and not subject to further evaluation. The County will not consider

or accept substitutions for **Item Nos. 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18 and 19**. All correspondence regarding this quote shall be directed to and issued by the Washington County Purchasing Department. Direct all inquiries to the County's Procurement Specialist I, Aaron Weisner, at 240-313-2330.

ITEM NO. 2: The County will not accept Get-A-Grip Gloves (79720PF-BKGR, 79730PF-BKGR, 79740PF-BKGR, 79750PF-BKGR, 79760PF-BKGR and 79770PF-BKGR) as a substitute for Item Nos. 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25.
