1. <u>QUOTATION SUBMISSION</u>: Quotations are to be enclosed in a sealed opaque envelope bearing the name of the Quoter and marked "QUOTATION – (Q-23-751) FERTILIZER." Quotations are to be addressed to the Washington County Purchasing Department, Washington County Administration Complex, 100 West Washington Street, Third Floor, Suite 3200, Hagerstown, MD 21740. Please direct all inquiries to Brandi Naugle, CPPB, Buyer at 240-313-2330, fax 240-313-2331. *Facsimile or Electronic Bids will not be accepted*.

<u>NOTE:</u> All Quoters must enter the Washington County Administrative Complex through either the front door at the 100 West Washington Street entrance or through the rear entrance (w/blue canopy roof) which is handicap accessible and must use the elevator to access the Purchasing Department to submit their quote and/or to attend the Pre-Quotation Conference and/or the Quote Opening. Alternate routes are controlled by a door access system. The general public will be subject to wand search and will be required to remove any unauthorized items from the building prior to entry. Prohibited items include but are not limited to: Weapons of any type; Firearms, ammunition and explosive devices; Cutting instruments of any type - including knives, scissors, box cutters, work tools, knitting needles, or anything with a cutting edge, etc.; Pepper spray, mace or any other chemical defense sprays; and Illegal substances.

All interested quoters wishing to take part in the meeting via teleconference shall call 240-313-2330 prior to the meeting to receive instructions. All interested quoters are requested to take part in the conference/teleconference. Participation in this meeting is not mandatory, but it is strongly encouraged.

- 3. <u>QUOTATION OPENING</u>: Quotations must be received and time-stamped in the Purchasing Department no later than 3:00 P.M., (EDT/EST) Wednesday, May 24, 2023. Quotations will be opened and read at that time in the Washington County Administration Complex, Third Floor Conference Room 3000, 100 West Washington Street, Hagerstown, Maryland. All interested parties are invited to hear a reading of the quotes. All quoters who wish to hear a reading of the quotes via teleconference shall call 240-313-2330 prior to the meeting to receive instructions.
- 4. <u>AWARD OF CONTRACT</u>: Washington County shall award the contract to the responsible, responsive low Quoter based on the total sum for the product. Carelessness in quoting prices, or in preparation of quotation otherwise, will not relieve the Quoter. Erasures or changes in quotations must be initialed.
- 5. <u>DELIVERY LOCATIONS</u>: Delivery shall be scheduled to start on or after, Monday, August 1, 2023, on an as needed basis; Saturday or Sunday deliveries shall not be acceptable.

A purchase order will be issued within ten (10) days to the successful Quoter. F.O.B. Destination, Inside Delivery, Black Rock Golf Course, Maintenance Building, 20317 Mt. It is expressly understood that in the case of the failure of the Quoter to complete delivery of the supplies within the time specified, except with the written consent of the County, the County shall reserve the right to deduct any monies due or which become due the Quoter in the amount of one (1%) percent per consecutive calendar day of the quoted amount of each unit for each and every day elapsing between the time stipulated and the completion date.

- 6. <u>DISCOUNTS</u>: Quoted prices are to be net thirty (30) calendar days; all discounts are to be deducted and reflected in net prices.
- 7. **<u>DISPUTES</u>**: In cases of disputes as to whether or not an item or service quoted or delivered meets specifications, the decision of the County Commissioners or authorized representative shall be final and binding on both parties.
- 8. <u>EQUAL OPPORTUNITY</u>: The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age and disability in employment or the provision of services. - **9. EXCEPTION:** The submission of a quote shall be considered an agreement to all items, conditions, and specifications provided herein and in the various quotation documents unless specifically noted otherwise in the quotation.

Failure of any Quoter to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve such Quoter from any obligation under his/her bid as submitted. - 12. <u>PAYMENT</u>: Payment will be made within thirty (30) days after satisfactory acceptance and delivery by each using department as required based on deliveries as requested by that department. Invoices shall be submitted in duplicate to each using department.
- 13. <u>PAYMENT OF COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL TAXES</u>: Effective October 1, 1993, in compliance with Section 1-106(b)(3) of the Code of the Public Local Laws of Washington County, Maryland, "If a Bidder has not paid all taxes owed to the County or a municipal corporation in the County, the County Commissioners may reject the Bidder's bid."
- 14. POLITICAL CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE: In accordance with Maryland Code, <u>State Finance and Procurement Article</u>, §17-402, the Bidder shall comply with Maryland Code, <u>Election Law Article</u>, Title 14, which requires that every person that enters into contracts, leases, or other agreements with the State, a county, or any incorporated municipality, or their agencies during a calendar year in which the person receives in the aggregate \$100,000 or more, shall file with the State Administrative Board of Election Laws a statement disclosing contributions in excess of \$500 made during the reporting period to a candidate for elective office in any primary or general election. The statement shall be filed with the State Administrative Board of Election Laws: (1) before a purchase or execution of a lease or contract by the State, a county, an incorporated municipality or their agencies, and shall cover the preceding two (2) calendar years; and (2) if the contribution is made after the execution of a lease or contract, then twice a year, throughout the contract term, on: (a) February 5, to cover the 6-month period ending January 31; and (b) August 5, to cover the 6-month period ending July 31.
- 15. <u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the Quoter to perform the work, and the Quoter shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by or investigation of, such Quoter fails to satisfy the Owner that such Quoter is properly qualified to carry out the obligation of the Contract and to complete the work contemplated therein. Conditional quotations will not be accepted.
- 16. **RESERVATIONS:** The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotes, to waive formalities, informalities and technicalities therein. The Board reserves the right to contact a Quoter for clarifications and may, at its sole discretion, allow a Quoter to correct any and all formalities, informalities and technicalities in the best interest of Washington County, Maryland.
- 17. <u>SALES TAX:</u> Washington County Government is exempt from State of Maryland Sales Tax. The County's Maryland Sales Tax Exemption Number is 3000129 2. The County will provide a sales tax exemption certificate for the items provided under this contract.
- **18.** <u>SUBSTITUTIONS</u>: No substitutions will be considered nor accepted.
- **19.** <u>**TERM OF CONTRACT:**</u> All quoted prices shall be valid for a period of one year after contract start date.

- 20. <u>DELIVERY FAILURES</u>: Failure of a Quoter to deliver within the time specified, or within a reasonable time as interpreted by the Director of Purchasing or failure to make replacements of rejected products when so requested, immediately or as directed by the Director of Purchasing shall constitute authority for the Director of Purchasing to purchase in the open market products of comparable grade to replace the products rejected or not delivered. On all such purchases, the Quoter shall reimburse the County, within a reasonable time specified by the Director of Purchasing, for any expense incurred in excess of contract prices or the County may deduct such amount from monies owed the defaulting Quoter. Such purchases shall be deducted from contract quantities and the County reserves the right to cancel the contract.
- 21. <u>QUOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY</u>: Prior to contracting, private corporations must either be incorporated in the State of Maryland or registered with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation as a foreign corporation and must be in good standing.
